

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



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ACTION PHILOSOPHY CONDUCTED WITH MENTEES TO ASSESS THE LEARNING LEVELS OF STUDENTS BY THE FACULTY MEMBERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PHILOSOPHY

The aim of the Action Philosophy session with mentees was to evolve the sense of purpose in them. It is was well thought by the faculty members/ mentors that it is time to take a deep plunge into the inner self and connect with deeper values. To make the objective real, it is essential that we connect with nature around and take up a stewardship of nature activity. Students when brought close to nature, often flourish gathering the immense bounty.

The session/activity: Students were told to gather in groups around an old tree and feel the span of time that the tree had survived, sustaining all hardships. They were told to feel the depth till which the roots might have reached to find water underneath the soil. The students were also told to observe the insects who are living safely on the barks of the tree. Moreover, the serenity that nature provides if we connect in silence.



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
